Getting Started Overview

The steps you will follow to install and use FireEyes are:

1. Install the Firefox browser
2. Install the Firebug plugin
3. Log in to WorldSpace
4. Change Name and Password
5. Toggle project “on” in WorldSpace
6. Download the FireEyes extension from WorldSpace
7. Enable Java Platform plugin in Firefox
8. Open website to analyze in Firefox and launch FireEyes
9. Connect to the WorldSpace Server
10. Select a project
11. Begin analysis


Step 1: Install the Firefox browser

Go to <http://www.mozilla.org> and select the Download button. Follow the installation instructions.



Step 2: Install the Firebug plugin

1. Go to the Firebug homepage at <http://getfirebug.com>.
2. After selecting Install Firebug, choose the appropriate version of Firebug for your version of Firefox. The add-on installation window will automatically open.
3. Select the Firebug plugin and choose Install.
4. Restart Firefox.



Step 3: Log in to WorldSpace

1. **Enterprise WorldSpace users** should use the URL provided in your invitation email – *only* the portion from http:// through /FireEyes/ (i.e. http://servername/FireEyes/). **WorldSpace Public users** should go to http://worldspace.deque.com/FireEyes/ .
2. Enter your login / password.
3. Select the Login button.

Worldspace Sync and FireEyes are unprecedented, next-generation web accessibility tools that ensure both static and dynamic content within a web portfolio are compliant with standards such as Section 508, WCAG 1.0, and WCAG 2.0. They are both fully JavaScript-aware and handle event-based page content.

FireEyes and Worldspace Sync are the right tools for you, if your site:

- Uses AJAX, JavaScript, Flash, PDFs, or dynamic content
- Personalizes multiple user roles
- Displays pages based on user-entered data
- Uses a content management system, with or without templates
- Needs to be accessible, secure, and private

Step 4: Change Name and Password

If this is your very first time logging in to WorldSpace, you will want to change your name from the generic J. Doe to your actual name.

1. Select the Account Settings gear icon in the very top right hand corner of the screen.
2. Edit your personal information as you wish.
3. Select the Update button.

Step 5: Toggle Project “on” in WorldSpace

1. When you log in to WorldSpace you will be brought to one of two screens: Your Workspace or the Project Report.
2. On Your Workspace:
 - You will see a list of your favorite authorized Projects.
 - If you do not have any favorite projects yet, or the project you want to work with isn’t listed, select the **+ show all projects** link to see all of the projects you are authorized for.
 - Ensure the “Favorite Toggle” star is green for any projects you want to work with in FireEyes.

3. On the Project Report:
 - You will see the “Favorite Toggle” star next to the project name in the Choose Project drop down menu.
 - Ensure the “Favorite Toggle” star is green for any projects you want to work with in FireEyes.



Step 6: Download the FireEyes extension from WorldSpace

1. While logged into WorldSpace Sync, select the Download icon.



2. When the following dialog appears, select "Install Now":




3. Restart Firefox once installation is complete.
4. In order to log out of WorldSpace: Hover over your name in the top right corner to access the "logout" option.




Step 7: Enable Java Platform plugin in Firefox

1. Java Platform SE 5.0 (sometimes also referred to as Java 1.5.0) or higher must be installed and enabled in the browser. If Java is not enabled, or if an older version of Java is installed, then FireEyes will load but will show an error message.




2. If you get this error message you will need to install Java and/or enable the Java Platform plug-in for Mozilla browsers in order to use FireEyes. Go to <http://www.java.com/en/download/testjava.jsp> to test whether Java is working on your computer and what version is installed. Download the current, recommended version of Java and/or use the troubleshooting steps on the page.
3. If the java test webpage above shows that Java SE 5.0 or above is installed, you may need to verify that it is enabled in Firefox. From the Firefox menu, select Add-ons, and select the Plugins tab. Verify that the Java Platform plugin is installed, up-to-date, and enabled.



4. Restart your browser.

Step 8: Open website to analyze in Firefox and launch FireEyes

1. Launch the Firefox browser.
2. Navigate to the website you wish to analyze.
3. Launch the Firebug plugin by activating the Firebug icon in the far right corner of the Firefox tool bar or by pressing the F12 key.
4. The Firebug console will appear at the bottom of your browser screen.
5. FireEyes will appear as a new tab in the Firebug interface.



Step 9: Connect to the WorldSpace Server


1. If you have previously logged in to the WorldSpace Server from the same computer, FireEyes will automatically log in to your WorldSpace account. This will synchronize all of your projects and settings from the WorldSpace server. You will see the "Logged in" notice on the FireEyes toolbar.



2. If FireEyes does not automatically log in to your WorldSpace account you will see the "Not logged in" notice on the FireEyes toolbar.



3. Go to the Settings tab to log in to your WorldSpace account.
4. **Enterprise WorldSpace users** enter the Server URL provided in the invitation email – *only* the portion from <http://> through </FireEyes/> (i.e. <http://servername/FireEyes/>).
- WorldSpace Public users** use <http://worldspace.deque.com/FireEyes/>.
5. Enter your Email address and Password.
6. Select the Update & Login button.
7. Verify Log in status.




Step 10: Select Project

1. If the desired project is not listed next to the "Logged in" symbol, switch to the required project by selecting the "Switch" button.



2. Select the appropriate project from the drop down list that appears in the dialog and select the "Switch to project" button.



3. If the project you want is not in the list, ensure that you have designated it as a "Favorite" in your WorldSpace account. See Step 5: Toggle Project "on" in WorldSpace.

Step 11: Begin Analysis

You are now ready to analyze your project. Go to the Current Document tab in FireEyes and select the Now button. You should see a modal dialog pop up telling you the number of issues that FireEyes found on the page. If this does not happen, please restart your browser and try again.
