- **The Senior Leader Program (SLP)** takes career public service professionals to new heights in leadership and management. It's especially designed for senior level managers (a minimum of GS-14 or its equivalent) in the Federal Government and military, as well as state and local officials.
- The program meets the Office of Personnel Management's (OPM) **80-hour, interagency training** requirement in the Executive Core Qualifications, focusing specifically on higher-level competencies such as external awareness, strategic thinking, political savvy and accountability.
