Overview

Excellence in Government Fellows Program (EIG)

- For future leaders of the agency, committed to personal and organizational development
- “Public Service Leadership” – *only* government employees
- *Participants stay in their job* and meet every 6-8 weeks for 3 day sessions
- 24 days over one year

Program Details

Who Should Apply

- EIG is for GS-14 to GS-15 (or equivalent).
- Candidates must:
 - Have a record of strong accomplishment and demonstrate high-potential in OPM's Executive Core Qualifications
 - Have the ability and interest to commit and contribute fully to the program
 - Be GS-14s to GS-15s or the equivalent in the military, state or other pay systems (exceptional GS-13s are also encouraged to apply)
 - Be capable of traveling to Washington, D.C. and Williamsburg, VA for sessions
 - Have the support of their agency or department



Location

- Most sessions occur in the Washington, D.C. metro area
- One session requires travel to Williamsburg, VA



Tuition

- **Tuition is \$9,900.00**
- This includes:
 - All coaching and facilitation
 - Course materials (e.g., books, articles)
 - Assessments, one-on-one coaching and individualized development planning
 - Online collaboration tools
 - Access to the Partnership's resources, expertise and networks
 - Invitations to ongoing activities
